HIGHLIGHTS:

STOP School Violence: School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) grants, due May 31.

Administered by the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) office, the School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) is authorized by the Students, Teachers and Officers Preventing (STOP) School Violence Act of 2018. Funding is available for: coordination with local law enforcement; training for local law enforcement officers to prevent student violence; placement and use of metal detectors, locks, lighting, and other deterrent measures; technology for expedited notification of local law enforcement during an emergency, and more.

Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-based Program (COAP) grants, due June 5.

The purpose of the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-based Program (COAP) is to identify, respond to, treat, and support those impacted by the opioid epidemic. Category 1 funding of COAP is to support "locally driven responses to the opioid epidemic that expand access to supervision, treatment, and recovery support services across the criminal justice system; support law enforcement and other first responder diversion programs for non-violent drug offenders; promote education and prevention activities; and address the needs of children impacted by the opioid epidemic."

Body-warn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Local Law Enforcement Agencies grant, due June 5.

The purpose of the Body-warn Camera (BWC) Policy and Implementation Program, administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance, is to help agencies develop a comprehensive BWC program as one way to improve officer safety and contribute to building community trust. While the grant can be used to purchase BWCs, grant proposals must "describe a deliberate and phased plan to deploy this technology, as well as specific ways it will be used to enhance the applicant agency's mission."

Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA) Letters of Interest due July 5.

The WIFIA program is a federal credit program administered by EPA for eligible water and wastewater infrastructure projects. The program has \$60 million in FY19 to cover 49% of the total project cost for loan recipients. This year's NOFA highlights the importance of protecting public health including reducing exposure to

lead and other contaminants in drinking water systems, updating the nation's aging infrastructure and reusing/recycling water in new or innovative ways. Prospective borrowers must submit a letter of interest (LOI) by July 5, 2019. EPA will select projects that it intends to fund and invite them to continue to the application process.

Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Transportation Discretionary Grants (replacing the TIGER Program), due July 15.

BUILD is a competitive program to be awarded to projects with a "significant local or regional impact," and has a stronger focus to advantage rural areas, splitting 50/50 the percentage of funds spent in rural vs. urban areas, up from 30% rural / 70% urban. The Department revised the definition for rural and urban projects from previous BUILD/TIGER rounds to two categories, consistent with the funding maximums for each category, thus the threshold for rural versus urban is 200,000 population.
