Generative artificial intelligence (AI) describes algorithms that can be used to **create new content**.

How is it used?

Written Content Creation & Adaptation

- Drafting written text in a desired style, length
- Tone Manipulation, i.e. to soften language or professionalize text
- Summarization offering shortened versions
- Simplification Breaking down titles, creating outlines and extracting key content

Developing Visual and Audio Content


- Photo & video

Enhance Productivity and Augmentation

- Drafting
- Communication and marketing
- Research

Reduction of Costs

Workflow automation

Enhanced Customer Service and Engagement

- Chat bots
- Analyzing input
- Employee engagement

Data Informed Decision Making

Large volume data analysis



Risk Factors

Transparency

- What's in the algorithm?
- How is gen AI being used?

Accuracy

- Limitations of certain tools
- "junk in, junk out"

Intellectual Property & Copyright

Hard to determine original sources in the model

Cybersecurity & Fraud

- Deep fakes

Confidential Data & PII

Can't use confidential information or PII in prompts

Public Information

- Prompts /queries and outputs
- Individual/personal accounts



Risk Factors

 Bias – if input data has bias, then output data is at risk of replicating that bias

Mitigating Risk: Usage Policies

- AI Usage Policies can provide a framework for local governments to manage risk
- Policies can address:
 - Responsible and ethical usage of generative AI
 - Protection of sensitive data
 - Adaptation to advancing AI technology
 - o Transparency to constituents and municipal staff

Policy Statement / Purpose

- The initial policy statement or purpose provides the organization's stance towards the usage of Al platforms. These statements may:
 - Acknowledge the potential impacts of AI technology
 - Consider the threats and responsibilities of AI usage
 - Encourage ethical and responsible use of AI

Generative AI is a tool. We are responsible for the outcomes of our tools. For example, if autocorrect unintentionally changes a word - changing the meaning of something we wrote, we are still responsible for the text. Technology enables our work, it does not excuse our judgment nor our accountability.

Supervisory Controls

 What supervisory checks are in place at each level to ensure the responsible and ethical use of AI content?

- Individual
- Departmental
- Organizational

AI Citations

- AI Generated content has potential to provide misleading information and imagery or utilize potentially copyrighted material.
- To ensure transparency and maintain public trust, several Al policies require or encourage employees to:
 - Embed citations on all Al generated imagery or videos
 - Cite AI generated text in publications
 - Track employee usage of AI platforms



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Records Management



Any information and/or content that is generated using Al technology may be subject to the Public Records Act.



Municipal employees must exert caution when handling sensitive information and utilizing generative AI.
