RE: Response to Request for Public Assistance Deadline Extension FEMA-4827-DR-NC

Dear Assistant Director Stanton:

On October 23, 2024, the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management (NCDEM/Recipient) submitted a request to extend the original deadline for submitting Requests for Public Assistance (RPA) for the counties designated for Public Assistance (PA) in DR-4827-NC. The original deadline was October 28, 2024. NCEM has requested a deadline extension to December 27, 2024.

FEMA may extend the time limitations for RPAs when the Recipient justifies that an extension is necessary based on extenuating circumstances beyond the Recipient's or Subrecipient's control. *See* 44 C.F.R. Section 206.202. FEMA recognizes the Recipient's justification for a time extension.

In response to the Recipient's request, **FEMA** is extending the deadline to submit RPAs. The RPA deadline is January 7, 2025. This extension applies to all counties designated for PA in **DR-4827-NC**. This extension will help ensure sufficient time for applicants to submit RPAs and reduce any applicant confusion regarding the deadline date.

The State of North Carolina requests a 60-day Time Extension for eligible applicants to submit their Request for Public Assistance (RPA) to assess and validate damage and cost caused by DR-4827-NC from **October 28, 2024**, to **December 27, 2024**. The catastrophic impact of Tropical Storm Helene has caused an unprecedented amount of response efforts that is currently ongoing.
