Highlight

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), which has jurisdiction over the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), opened the [FY24 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response \(SAFER\) Grant Program Notice of Funding Opportunity \(NOFO\)](#), and the [FY24 Fire Prevention and Safety \(FP&S\) Grant Program NOFO](#).

The SAFER grant, with approximately \$324 million in program funding, provides financial assistance to fire departments to increase frontline firefighters through 1. the hiring of firefighters; and 2. the recruitment and retention of volunteer firefighters. The purpose of the FP&S grant, with about \$32.4 million, is “to enhance the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards. The FP&S Program offers grants to support activities in two categories: 1. activities designed to reach high-risk target groups and mitigate incidences of death and injuries caused by fire and fire-related hazards ("Fire Prevention and Safety Activity"); and 2. research and development activities aimed at improving firefighter safety ("Firefighter Safety Research and Development Activity).” Application materials and more information may be accessed, [here](#).

The deadline to apply for either grant is **July 3, 2025**.
